

TERMS OF USE

1. INTRODUCTION

Access to Volteo Digital's website (hereinafter, the 'Website') is free, except for the cost of connection through the telecommunications network provided by the access provider contracted by the User.

The User agrees to use the Website diligently, properly, and lawfully, avoiding any action that may damage the image, interests, or rights of Volteo Digital or third parties. If the User violates these Terms of Use, the company reserves the right to limit, suspend, or terminate their access to the Website without prior notice, taking any necessary technical measures.

Volteo Digital also reserves the right to modify, suspend, or terminate the provision of services through the Website at any time, without prejudice to the provisions of the General Terms and Conditions of Contract.

2. INTELLECTUAL AND INDUSTRIAL PROPERTY
